Which routines and places are a good fit for embedding strategies to support the child's use of a priority skill? Who will help?



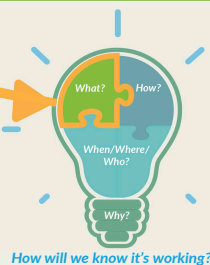
Grandma can embed strategies while at the church playgroup to support Sofia's priority skill of Sofia saying a word back when others talk to her.
